900A-, 900B-, 2900A-, AND 2900B-TYPE TELEPHONE SETS IDENTIFICATION, INSTALLATION, AND CONNECTIONS

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section contains information on the 900A- (MD), 900B- (Fig. 1), 2900A- (MD), and 2900B- (Fig. 2) type, DESIGN LINE* telephone (Exeter) sets.

1.02 This section is reissued to:

- Show the 900B3-58 and 2900B3-58 telephone set MD
 - Show the 900B5-58 and 2900B5-58 telephone sets MD
 - Add information on the 900B6-58 and 2900B6-58 telephone sets.

1.04 ♦The 900B6-58 and 2900B6-58 telephone sets are similar to the 900B5-58 (MD) and 2900B5-58 (MD) sets except for the appliques. The 900B6-58 sets have a new floral (841416035) and etched metal (840396451) applique replacing the older floral and iridescent appliques. The 2900B6-58 sets have a new floral (841416027) and etched metal (840396360) applique replacing the older floral and iridescent appliques.

1.05 The customer's premises must be properly wired with an appropriate connecting block or jack in order to accept the D4BU-29 plug-ended mounting cord.

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2. IDENTIFICATION

2.01 The 900-type (rotary dial) and 2900-type (TOUCH-TONE® dial) equipped telephone sets are new DESIGN LINE telephone sets being made available to the customer. The customer buys the housing and handset from the telephone company and the telephone company retains ownership of the transmission and signaling components which are mounted to the lower housing and in the handset.

Ordering Guide (Refer to Table A)

2.02 Basic Telephone Set Ordering Information:

Example: Set, Telephone, \$900B6-58† is a white desk set equipped with a rotary dial and four different customer option applique (Fig. 1).

2.03 These telephone sets are intended to be used as single line or two-party desk sets and cannot be used on four- and eight-party service.

2.04 Optional Component (order separately):

• 819041708 (P-90D170) Guard Assembly (polarity guard).

3. INSTALLATION AND CONNECTIONS

- 3.01 These telephone sets are furnished from the factory fully assembled and wired for bridged ringing. The P1A ringer is shipped from the factory with the bias spring in the low bias position. To connect the telephone set, plug the mounting cord into a 625-type connecting block or if the existing jack is a 548A or equivalent, use the 1A converter, ordered separately.
- 3.02 The internal connections for the 900A, B, 2900A, and B telephone sets, for nonkey system use, are shown in Fig. 5, 7, 8, and 10, respectively.
- 3.03 Connections for 1A KTS require no telephone set modifications and are wired same as Fig. 5, 7, 8, and 10.
- 3.04 Connections for use with 1A1 or 1A2 KTS are shown in Table F and Fig. 6 for 900A, Fig. 7 for 900B, Fig. 9 for 2900A, and Fig. 10 for 2900B telephone sets.
- 3.05 To gain access to the interior of these sets for wiring changes, refer to Part 4.
- 3.06 Refer to Table G for connections when installing polarity guard in the 2900A and 2900B telephone sets when instructed by local administrative practices or procedures.




Fig. 3-900B or 2900B Telephone Set, Bottom View




Fig. 4—900B Telepone Set With Upper Housing and Trim Ring Removed

3.07 If a polarity guard is required, mount the guard assembly to the two bosses located in front of dial on the lower housing (Fig. 4).

3.08 Line and Ringer Connections:

- Refer to Tables B (900A), C (900B), D (2900A), and E (2900B) for single line and two-party service for these telephone sets.
- (2) For adjustments and ringer cutoff feature of the P1A ringer, refer to Section 501-259-101.

4. REMOVAL OF TELEPHONE COMPANY-OWNED COMPONENTS

4.01 When it is desired to discontinue telephone service of these DESIGN LINE telephone sets, proceed as follows.

- Remove handset and mounting cords from the telephone set.
- (2) Remove upper housing by loosening (4) screws in bottom of lower housing.
- (3) Remove the telephone company-owned components that can be easily removed.
- (4) Reassemble upper housing to lower housing.
- **4.02** Follow local procedures for returning company-owned components.
- 4.03 When it is desired to return a set to Western Electric for repair, it should be packed using the D-180600 Kit of Parts which contains packing materials and instructions.




Fig. 5-900A (MD) Telephone Set, Connections for Nonkey




Fig. 6-900A (MD) Telephone Set Wired for 1A1 for 1A2 KTS (Note 1)




Fig. 7-900B Telephone Set, Connections for Key or Nonkey




Fig. 8-2900A (MD) Telphone Set, Connections for Nonkey




Fig. 9—2900A (MD) Telephone Set Wired for 1A1 or 1A2 KTS (Note 1)




Fig. 10-2900B Telephone Set, Connections for Key or Nonkey
