

- FOR NEGATIVE STATIONS IN OFFICES WITHOUT ANI, (R) LEAD FROM 426A TUBE MAY BE CONNECTED TO G IF RINGER OPERATION IS MARGINAL.
- WIRED FOR NEGATIVE RING PARTY FOR CLASSES OF SERVICE NOT SHOWN, REFER TO TABLE A.
